

Prevention/Intervention Program(PIP)

It is the responsibility of the experienced, to assist and monitor the inexperienced, as they acquire those skills necessary to become a dynamic educator, while educating our children. These skills can only be attained by on the job training.

PIP offers an intense 21-hours of hands on activities for teachers to develop or enhance skills in preparing for the beginning of the school year. The program stresses skill development in the areas of first day procedures; development and implementation of lesson plans; maintenance and accuracy of grade books, progress reports, report cards; parent communication; and teacher responsibilities during field trips and fire/disaster drills. Program participants will receive training in the application of classroom management and appropriate behavior support strategies researched and documented by Fred Jones in “Tools for Teaching”.

PIP is then followed by monitoring and support with 8 campus visits by an External Support Consultant(ESC) to review, reflect, and make adjustments to their goals set for personal professional growth. “Your Personal Mentoring and Planning Guide For The First Sixty Days of Teaching”, by Robert L. Debruyne will be used to facilitate and document achievement of goals.

Program participants can be recycled through any area of development or enhancement during the academic year enrolled in the program. This decision can be made by the program participant and/or at the recommendation of the campus administrator or ESC.
